Families will be able to picnic in front of the Kids Entertainment stage, participate in fun, educational activities, enjoy the kid's rides and jumping castles and soak in the carnival atmosphere.

Parents can explore a tantalizing range of stalls and markets at the 2007 Surry Hill Festival. Discover unique treasures at stalls reminiscent of a Middle Eastern bazaar. Visit the Artisans quarter featuring hand-made crafts and artwork. Indulge in freshly prepared local gourmet fare at the food stalls – whether it's for brunch, lunch or early dinner – or just to snack on throughout the day.

Five entertainment stages will pump out live rock, jazz, acoustic and world music throughout the day.
